

CURLING

★ ATTENTION ★

Everyone that steps on the ice needs to have a signed waiver.

Clean off your shoes of salt before stepping on the ice.

Beer must be consumed off the ice!

DON'T PICK UP THE STONES, always slide them!

Players under 18 must be supervised by an adult.

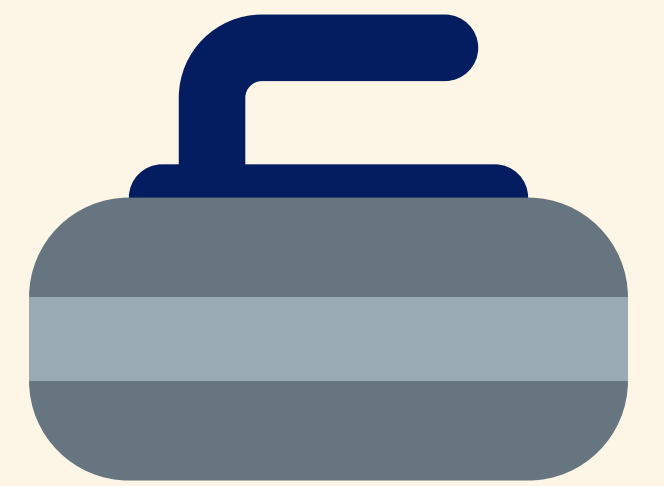
Sheet size and equipment is not regulation.

OBJECTIVE

The purpose of a game is to score points by getting stones closer to the house, or the "button", than the other team's stones. At each end of the sheet there are two circles that look like targets, known as houses. The center with the star is the button.

HOW TO PLAY

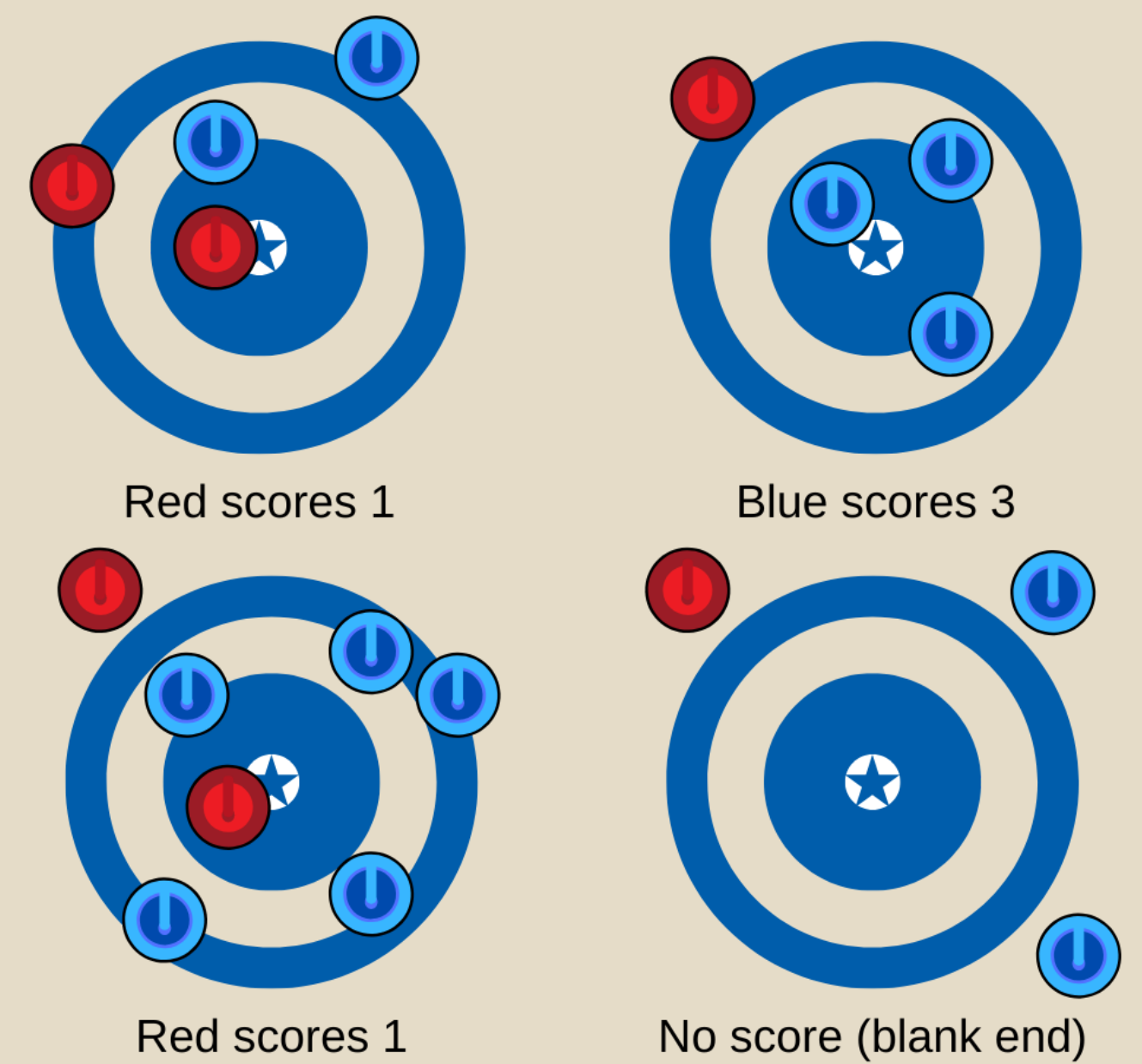
- Two teams are required, half of your team will be at one end and the other half at the other.
- Teams will flip a coin or play Rock, Paper, Scissors to determine who goes first.
- An "end" in curling is when each team has thrown four stones and the score has been decided. An official game at FSBC has 10 ends.
- During an end, the teams alternate turns throwing stones.
- Stones must be thrown before the Hog Line, which is marked on the sheet at each end. Additionally, the stones must land at or past the playing end's Hog Line to be kept in play. If they don't reach the Hog Line, pull them off, out of play.
- During the end, one side of the rink will be throwers, while the other team members on the opposite side sweeps and directs the stones.
- Sweepers can remove the snow in the stone's path to "speed it up" or add snow in the path to "slow it down".
- Once a team scores in the end, the Hammer (last throw in an end) for the next end will go to the team that didn't score. If there is no score at the end, the Hammer is retained by the same team.



HOW TO SCORE

- In order for a curling stone to be considered for scoring, some part of it must be in the house.
- During each end, the team with the stone closest to the center (button) is the only team that scores points. If the team has multiple stones closer to the center, then the opponents closest stone, they score multiple points.

For example, the blue team's 4 stones are 12 inches, 16 inches, 17 inches, and 20 inches away from the center. The red team's stones are 14 inches, 15 inches, 16 inches, and 19 inches away from the center. The Blue Team in this example would score 1 point.
